Laura is on the DVGBC Board. As members of the Residential Workgroup they co-authored Green Homes 101, a green building primer.

Chad has championed Green Building practices targeting modest market priced urban housing with deep energy efficiency and sustainable materials.

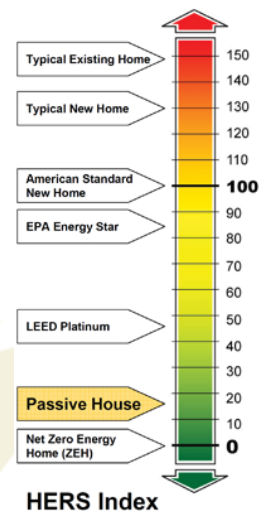
